Children are entrusted to us for the future. It is our primary responsibility to recognize them as individuals, to respect their rights, to protect and protect them against all kinds of psychological, physical, commercial, etc. exploitation.

The World Health Organization defines child abuse as follows: "All acts that adversely affect the health, physical and psychosocial development of the child, and are applied knowingly or unknowingly by an adult, society or the state. behaviors are mistreatment of the child.

"To ensure this;

- We do not allow child labor to be used in our own institutions and we expect the same sensitivity from all our business partners.
- We organize trainings and support related projects to raise awareness about the protection of children's rights.
- When we witness suspicious actions related to children, we first inform the hotel management and ask for help from official institutions when deemed necessary.

In accordance with our policy;

- Do not leave your young children under the age of 0-12 alone in your room,
- To deliver your children to strangers at the hotel and not to go out of the hotel,
- You should not allow your children under the age of 18 to use alcohol,
- Respect children's rights,
- You should not engage in behaviors aimed at child neglect and abuse,
- We ask you, our valued guests and employees, to report to the management those who act against children's rights and abuse.

In line with the reported complaints; The security forces will be informed by the management and the necessary legal actions will be taken.

In accordance with national and international laws to protect children's rights, child abuse has criminal sanctions and imprisonment.
